

7. BACKGROUND/ANALYSIS

The purpose of the ordinance is to remove (repeal) outdated language in the City Code as it relates to the Parks Bureau and Civic Stadium. Originally the Parks Bureau was responsible for managing the Civic Stadium, as established in City Code, Title 3 Administration; guidance for rental charges for Civic Stadium was established in Title 20 Parks. Additionally certain responsibilities for MERC employees for traffic and non-moving violations for Memorial Coliseum and Civic Stadium were established in Title 3 Administration. These Code provisions are out of date. The Civic Stadium is now operated by a private firm, Peregrine Sports LLC, as a major league soccer venue, through a contract managed by the Office of Management and Finance.
