ORDINANCE No. 185712

* Extend an Intergovernmental Agreement with Multnomah County Drainage District No. 1, Peninsula Drainage District No. 1 and Peninsula Drainage District No. 2 through June 30, 2013 for stormwater management services (Ordinance; amend Contract No. 51358)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. Ordinance No. 174615 established an Intergovernmental Agreement effective July 1 of 2000 for provision of stormwater management services with Multnomah County Drainage District No. 1. Peninsula Drainage District No. 1 and Peninsula Drainage District No. 2 (the Districts). When the IGA was effective the City ceased direct billing for stormwater management services in the Drainage Districts.
- 2. Ordinance No. 185610 directed the Bureau of Environmental Services to commence direct billing for stormwater services within the Districts on July 1, 2013.
- The IGA is not effective for the current fiscal year and therefore the Bureau of Environmental 3. Services cannot recover costs for services provided in the Districts unless it is extended.
- The Bureau of Environmental Services and the Districts have agreed to extend the IGA through 4. June 30, 2013.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

The Commissioner of Public Affairs is hereby authorized to execute on behalf of the City an a. extension to the Intergovernmental Agreement with the Districts for the purposes described in Section 1.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because the proposed extension is necessary in order for the Bureau of Environmental Services to recover stormwater management costs reflected in the current Adopted Budget and approved rates; therefore this Ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
