ORDINANCE NO. 185871

* Amend the expenditure authorization for subrecipient contract with Transition Projects, Inc. for an additional \$269,000 for services to operate Women's Winter Shelter and provide for payment. (Ordinance; amend Contract No. 32000784)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds that:

- 1. The Portland Housing Bureau (PHB) executed Master Ordinance No. 185466 for the provision of services in furthering the goals of its strategic plan including services to operate winter shelter for people experiencing homelessness.
- 2. There is a critical need for expanded winter shelter and services from November through mid-April to safeguard the lives of vulnerable, unsheltered individuals from inclement weather conditions that pose a threat of severe illness and/or death due to exposure.
- 3. PHB will contract with Transition Projects to operate a Winter Shelter for the 2012-13 winter season. This center can provide shelter for up to 70 single women per night.
- 4. Funding in the amount of \$269,000 in City general funds will be added to the Transition Projects Inc. subrecipient contract not to exceed the amount of \$3,528,454 through the allocation of existing appropriations for this purpose in PHB's FY 2012-13 Ending Homelessness Initiative budget.

NOW THEREFORE, the Council directs that:

- a. The Bureau Director and City Auditor are authorized to execute and amend the agreement with Transition Projects Inc., for the purpose described above.
- b. The Mayor and Auditor are hereby authorized to draw and deliver warrants chargeable to the Portland Housing Bureau's operating fund budget when demand is presented and approved by the proper authority.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because the program funds must be obligated within required timeframes; therefore, this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by Council.
