

# ORDINANCE No. 186140.

Authorize a contract with the lowest responsible bidder for the construction of the NE 148<sup>th</sup> Basin Water Quality Facility Project No. E07177 for estimated amount of \$1,116,000 (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. The NE 148<sup>th</sup> Basin Water Quality Facility project will construct a pollution reduction facility to treat stormwater from an existing municipal storm sewer system serving the NE 148<sup>th</sup> drainage basin.
2. The Columbia Slough has been identified as water quality limited. Construction of the water quality facility will provide partial compliance with the City's TMDL, NPDES MS4 Permit and the Columbia Slough Sediment Consent Order.
3. Environmental Services has prepared plans and specifications for treating stormwater prior to discharging to the Columbia Slough.
4. The estimated cost is \$1,116,000. Funds are available in the Sewer System Operating Fund, FY 2013-2014 Budget, Bureau of Environmental Services, Project No. E07177.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Commissioner in charge is authorized to execute a contract with the lowest responsive bidder for the purpose described in Section 1.
- b. The Mayor and Auditor are hereby authorized to draw and deliver warrants chargeable to the Sewer System Operating Fund Budget when demand is presented and approved by the proper authority.


