ORDINANCE No. 186177

* Authorize contract and provide for payment for construction of the Portland Police Training Center Remodel project at an estimated cost of \$4,300,000. (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. In May 2012 Limited Tax Revenue and Refunding Bonds were issued in the amount of \$15,000,000 for the purchase of property and construction of a training center.
- 2. In April 2012 a property located at 14912 NE Airport Way was purchased for \$6,400,000. The 9.6 acre site contains 60,000 square feet of warehouse buildings to be remodeled for the training center program.
- 3. In June 2012 Scott Edwards Architecture, LLP was selected through an RFP-QBS (FAC022) process to provide architectural and engineering services for the project in the amount of \$499,748.
- 4. Ordinance 185453, passed by Council on June 21, 2012 authorized the City to enter into a sole source contract with Action Target of Provo, Utah in the amount of \$2,086,000 for the purchase and installation of shooting range equipment and ventilation systems for the two shooting ranges.
- 5. Scott Edwards Architecture, LLP has completed the construction documents and submitted them to the Bureau of Development Services for permitting on June 4, 2013.
- 6. It is anticipated an Invitation for Bids will be issued in the next several months with construction to begin in January-February 2014 with completion in mid 2014.
- 7. The construction cost to remodel the buildings for the training center is estimated to be \$4,300,000. The confidence level of this estimate is rated as moderate in that a final cost estimate is not yet complete and as more detail from the permit process is provided the cost estimate can change. The construction estimate is within the program budget for the training center.

NOW THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Chief Procurement Officer and Auditor are hereby authorized to execute a contract with the lowest responsive and responsible bidder for the Portland Police Training Center Remodel Project.
- b. The Mayor and Auditor are hereby authorized to draw and deliver checks chargeable to the year 2013-14 budget when demand is presented and approved by the proper authorities.

SECTION 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists in order to avoid additional expenses and a delay in the completion of this project; therefore, this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by Council.
