Commissioner Fritz announced the process ordinance would be coming, at a Council hearing on July 24. She also briefed members of the Portland Commission on Disability. Putting the Ordinance on the Council agenda in advance of commencing the hiring process allows everyone in the community to be aware of and comment on the proposed alternative process.
