

ORDINANCE No. 186272

* Add the Portland Police Honor Guard to the list of organizations eligible to use the voluntary payroll deduction system (Ordinance; amend Code Section 5.08.140)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. The Portland Police Honor Guard provides service at funerals for current and retired officers, as well as ceremonial duties at police memorials each spring. The Honor Guard also presents the colors at events for law enforcement and other community groups and parades.
2. The Portland Police Honor Guard will use contributions to purchase flags for ceremonies and fund officer travel to services and events. Funds will be maintained within a Police Special Revenue Fund designated for these purposes.
3. The Portland Police Honor Guard should be added to the list of organizations eligible to use the payroll deduction system under Code Section 5.08.140 Salary Deduction.
4. It is in the City's interest to add the Portland Police Honor Guard to the list of those organizations eligible to use the payroll deduction system not required to pay the fee described in Subsection B.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Mayor and Auditor are hereby authorized to add the Portland Police Honor Guard to the list of those organizations eligible to use the payroll deduction system under Code Section 5.08.140 Salary Deduction and not required to pay the fee described in Subsection B.
- b. City Code 5.08.140 shall be amended as described in Exhibit A.

Section 2. The Council declares an emergency exists to prevent delay of the mutual benefits to the City and the Portland Police Honor Guard of this amendment to the City Code. Therefore, this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.


