

ORDINANCE NO. 186280

* Authorize a grant agreement with Janus Youth Programs in the amount of \$75,000 to support the Village Market Project at New Columbia. (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. In coordination with Janus Youth Programs and Home Forward, the City will support Janus Youth Program's Village Market Project.
2. The Village Market Project provides access to healthy affordable food for the residents of New Columbia and Portsmouth Neighborhood. The project brings the opportunity for community building, civic engagement, employment, health and hope to nearly 3,000 people living in New Columbia.
3. The Village Market Project also serves as a model for the region and helps build the growing case for healthy retail access in our most vulnerable neighborhoods. It provides an example for addressing "food deserts" and for promoting the "twenty minute neighborhood" concept.
4. City support of the market will cover materials and supplies for operations of the market and prepared foods deli, and the hiring and supervision of low-income community members who will operate the market.
5. Janus Youth Programs will administer funding for the Village Market Project.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Commissioner-in-charge is hereby authorized to enter into a grant agreement with Janus Youth programs with the agreement attached as Exhibit A.
- b. The mayor and City Auditor are hereby authorized to pay for said contract from the General Fund Special Appropriation.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because any delay in providing grant funding to allow Village Market to expeditiously proceed with procuring appropriate goods and services would harm the public interest; therefore, this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by Council.
