Authorize a contract and provide payment for the construction components of the Carolina Pump Main Phase 2 Project at an estimated cost of \$2,850,000 (Ordinance)

**2) Purpose of the Proposed Legislation:**

Construct a 24 inch pump main from SW Chestnut Street and SW Burlingame Avenue to tie into the existing Carolina Pump Main at Capitol Highway and Terwilliger Boulevard. The project will increase the reliability of the Burlingame Service Area and allow both the Fulton Pump Main and Carolina Pump Main systems to continue functioning in the event one component failed.

The estimated cost for the work under this construction contract is \$2,850,000. Funding of \$350,000 is available in the FY 2013-14 Budget and \$2,500,000 will be requested in the FY 2014-15 Budget.

This project has \$690,000 budgeted for FY 2013-14 and is part of the Distribution Mains Program which has a total program budget of \$15,800,000 for FY 2013-14. The proposed action will not result in a change in the forecast water rates. There is a high level of confidence for the work.
