

RESOLUTION No. 37040

Accept the 2013 North Portland Greenway Trail Alignment Plan; East Bank Esplanade to Kelley Point Park as a guide for future development of the Greenway Trail (Resolution)

WHEREAS the City of Portland supports the development and will continue to work towards the implementation of the North Portland Greenway Trail as shown in the River Plan/North Reach; and

WHEREAS Portland Parks & Recreation commissioned a buildable alignment plan until the alignment shown for the North Portland Greenway Trail Alignment in the River Plan/North Reach can be realized; and

WHEREAS the near term buildable plan was prepared with an advisory committee comprising representatives from the npGreenway, pedestrian advocates, neighborhood associations, local businesses, University of Portland and members at large; and


WHEREAS there were six PAC meetings and three open houses each with a public comment period and additional targeted outreach to gather public input during the project; and

WHEREAS the City of Portland will continue to work with other government agencies, local businesses along the alignment and Union Pacific Railroad to allow the trail to be constructed on railroad property through the Albina Yard and Ward Bluff; and

WHEREAS during construction the City of Portland will protect trees, avoid impacts to and enhance the natural environment adjacent to the trail alignment.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT the City Council affirms its acceptance of the 2013 North Portland Greenway Trail Alignment Plan ; East Bank Esplanade to Kelley Point Park (Exhibit A) as a guide for future development of the Greenway Trail.
