TO THE COUNCIL:

The Chief Procurement Officer has advertised and received bids for Bid Number 115943 for the NW Thurman St. Macleay Park Bridge Rehab for the Bureau of Transportation, with a project construction estimate of \$3,781,000.00. The Bureau of Transportation rated the level of project estimate confidence as High.

Bids were opened on October 24, 2013, and five (5) bids were received. The low bid of Cascade Bridge, LLC was deemed responsive to the requirements of the solicitation. and it is recommended that their bid be accepted at the unit price quoted for a total amount of \$3,190,420.75.

This is a federal-aid transportation project under the Oregon Department of Transportation (ODOT) Federal-Aid Highway Program. Ordinance No. 179568 authorized the Bureau of Transportation (PBOT) to participate in ODOT's Local Public Agency Certification Program for the delivery of federal-aid projects. On June 29, 2011, ODOT's Director informed the Mayor that PBOT had successfully completed the requirements to become fully certified, and City Council accepted ODOT's certification acknowledgement by Ordinance No. 184710. Under ODOT's certification, this project will be reviewed and audited by ODOT for federal-aid project compliance.

Part of the certification is that ODOT shall administer on behalf of the City ODOT's Disadvantaged Business Enterprise (DBE), Equal Employment Opportunity, and On-The-Job Training (OJT) programs. As such, ODOT establishes the minimum DBE goals for each federal-aid project in compliance with 49 CFR 26. The criteria used in assigning project goals includes, project location, size, duration, dollar value and the availability of DBE firms that can perform identified subcontracting opportunities. This project has a 3% DBE goal. Cascade Bridge, LLC has 3.07% DBE participation on this project, therefore ODOT deemed the contractor to be responsive to the DBE requirement.

Cascade Bridge, LLC has a current City of Portland Business Tax Registration and their EEO Certification is current through 12/13/13. The company is located in Vancouver, Washington, and is not a State Certified MWESB Contractor.

Cascade Bridge, LLC is in Full Compliance with the Equal Benefits Program.

Funds are available for this project under Owner Cost Center T00391.

It is further recommended that a Performance Bond and a Payment Bond each in the amount of 100% of the contract amount be furnished by the Contractor.

The bid sureties of the remaining bidders should be returned immediately in compliance with Section 5.34.410D of the City Code.
