a) What impacts are anticipated in the community from this proposed Council item?

This project will replace a line approximately 2,200 feet of deteriorated 74-in, 1 8-in, and 22-inch diameter sewer pipe on SE Alder, SE Morrison St, SE Morrison CT, SE 62nd and SE 61st needs replacing. Typical construction impacts to the community may include noise from construction equipment, vibration due to open trench work, odor due to the use of lining equipment, and disruption to traffic due to open trench work and other related construction activities. Some trees in the public right of-way will be trimmed prior to construction starting in order to minimize any impacts of large construction equipment operating nearby. In addition, six properties with nonconforming sewers will be required to connect to the improved public sewer lines in order to bring their properties into conformance with current standards.

b) Which community and business groups, under-represented groups, organizations, external government entities, and other interested parties were involved in this effort, and when and how were they involved?

The construction contracting community, including contractors certified with the State of Oregon as minority, women, and emerging small businesses. They became involved when the project advertised for bids on September 25, 2013.

c) How did public involvement shape the outcome of this Council item?

Bids received resulted in the award of the construction contract.

d) Who designed and implemented the public involvement related to this Council item?

Procurement Services advertised the project for bids and held the prebid meeting that was open to the construction contracting community, including contractors certified with the State as minority, women, and emerging small businesses.

- 7. BACKGROUND/ANALYSIS: Ordinance Number 186262 adopted September 25, 2013 authorized a contract and provided for payment for the SE 62nd Ave & SE Morrison Sewer Rehabilitation Project. The purpose of this project will be to construct approximately 2,200 feet of deteriorated 14-in, 18-in, and 22-inch diameter sewer pipe on SE Alder, SE Morrison St, SE Morrison Ct, SE 62nd and SE 61st that needs replacement. This project will also line a 24-inch sewer pipe between SE 61st and SE 60th and eliminate a portion of the sewer that runs on private property between SE 61st and SE 62nd.
- **8. FINANCIAL IMPACT:** The engineer's estimate for this project was \$1,500,000.00 and the confidence level was optimal. Funds are available in the Sewer System Operating Fund, FY 2014 Budget, Bureau of Environmental Services, WBS Element E09049.C60.
- 9. **RECOMMENDATION/ACTION REQUESTED:** Accept Recommendation to award contract to Canby Excavating, Inc. in the amount of \$1,608,837.00.

10. SCOPE OF WORK ON PROJECT: The project includes all labor, materials, tools, equipment, and supervision necessary to repair and rehabilitate the combination sewer along SE Morrison St between SE 60th and SE 65th Avenues.
