OAR Definition of TSP (Statewide Planning Goals)



"...a plan for one or more transportation facilities that are planned, developed, operated and maintained in a coordinated manner to supply continuity of movement between modes, and within and between geographic and jurisdictional areas."



PORTLAND

OAR re: Funding



"(5) "Funding requirements" means the requirements set out in the Transportation Planning Rule that require a funding plan for transportation facilities or improvements needed to avoid a significant effect on existing or planned transportation facilities."



Created within a regulatory context

Transportation Planning Rule: Implements Statewide Planning Goal 12 (Transportation).

Regional Transportation Plan: Prepared and adopted by MPO. Municipalities must comply with requirements. TSP must comply.
