The initiatives help support best practices in reducing homelessness in our community. In its first six months, *Women into Housing Now* has housed 107 female-headed households. *Home Start*, in its first three months, has housed 83 households.

b) Which community and business groups, under-represented groups, organizations, external government entities, and other interested parties were involved in this effort, and when and how were they involved?

A stakeholder group convened in Fall 2013 was comprised of law enforcement, elected officials, community partners, business leaders, and service providers.

c) How did public involvement shape the outcome of this Council item?

During its two meetings, the stakeholder group discussed various intervention and prevention tools, as well as the priority populations best served through a one-time investment. They prioritized short-term rent assistance, mental health street outreach, and mental health and additions treatment.
