ORDINANCE No. 186575

Revise Disabled Person Parking Code (Ordinance; amend Code Chapters 16.20 and 16.90)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. On January 2, 2008, Portland City Council approved Ordinance No. 181507, which temporarily extended the privileges for regular disabled parking permits in the City of Portland meter districts until June 30, 2008. On June 11, 2008, Portland City Council approved Ordinance 181914, temporarily extending the privileges again until December 31, 2008. On November 19, 2008, Portland City Council approved Ordinance No. 182345, temporarily extending the privileges again until June 30, 2009. On June 24, 2009, Portland City Council approved Ordinance No. 182935, temporarily extending the privileges again until June 30, 2011. On June 1, 2011, Portland City Council approved Ordinance No. 184628, temporarily extending the privileges again until December 31, 2011. On December 7, 2011, Portland City Council approved Ordinance No. 185036, temporarily extending the privileges again until December 31, 2012. On December 12, 2012, Portland City Council approved Ordinance No. 185785, temporarily extending the privileges again until June 30, 2013. On June 19, 2013, Portland City Council approved Ordinance No. 186096, temporarily extending the privileges again until December 31, 2013. On December 19, 2013, Portland City Council approved Ordinance No. 186394, temporarily extending the privileges again until June 30, 2014.
- 2. On December 19, 2007, Portland City Council adopted Resolution No. 36562, which established the Disabled Parking Task Force to Develop recommendations for Council on the implementation of Oregon State Senate Bill 716.
- 3. The Task Force began meeting in February 2008 to create a disabled parking program. On June 3, 2009, the Task Force submitted a Disabled Parking Recommendations proposal to council; this proposal was not adopted because it failed to garner support from the Portland Commission on Disability. Since then, the Task Force has reconvened approximately 27 times to advise the Portland Bureau of Transportation and the Commissioner-in-Charge in creation of a disabled parking program.
- 4. The Commissioner-in-Charge submitted a proposal for a disabled parking program to the Task Force for review and endorsement. This program will amend the privileges for regular disabled parking permits and will begin in July, 2014.
- 5. The Portland City Council voted on Resolution to change parking in metered districts for vehicles displaying regular disabled parking placards.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. Code Section 16.20.250 Disabled Person/Wheelchair User Zone; Code Section 16.20.440, Meter Fees; Code Section 16.20.640 Disabled Person Permit Metered; Code Section 16.20.645 Wheelchair User Disabled Person Parking Permit are amended effective July 1, 2014; Code Section 16.20.641 Disabled Person Placard Non-Metered Regulated Parking Zone is added effective July 1, 2014, as shown in Exhibit A.
- b. Code Section 16.90.097 and Code Section 16.90.445 is added effective July 1, 2014, as shown in Exhibit B.
