BACKGROUND/ANALYSIS: Ordinance Number 186456 adopted February 12, 2014 authorized a contract and provided for payment for the SE 122<sup>nd</sup> Ave: SE Holgate Boulevard to SE Ramona Street Sidewalk Infill Project.
