Establish annual cap on estimated foregone revenue for the Multiple-Unit Limited Tax Exemption Program (Resolution)

WHEREAS, in 1991, the Oregon Legislature passed legislation allowing local jurisdictions to forgo a portion of property tax revenue for a defined period of time as an incentive for the development of housing that achieve larger City affordable housing policy goals; and

WHEREAS, on behalf of the City of Portland, the Portland Housing Bureau administers the Multiple-Unit Limited Tax Exemption (MULTE) Program, authorized under Portland City Code 3.103; and

WHEREAS, Portland City Code 1.103.030 requires City Council to establish annually by Resolution a cap on estimated foregone revenue for the MULTE Program; and

WHEREAS, the 2013 cap on estimated foregone revenue for the MULTE Program was \$1 million and the number of affordable rental units supported by the MULTE Program can be maximized by an increase in the cap on estimated foregone revenue for 2014.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council establishes the annual cap on estimated foregone revenue for the MULTE Program at \$1,210,000 for the 2014 calendar year.
