The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- That portion of Lots 4 and 5, Chambreau's Factory Site Addition was acquired by the City for a wastewater pumping station.
- That the wastewater pumping station has been constructed and the remaining property is no longer needed by the City for this purpose or (other City bureaus having been polled) for any other public purpose.
- 3. That Delta Truck Parts Co., has been displaced by Penninsula Drainage District No. 2 for levee improvement, and has offered to purchase the remaining portion of Lots 4 and 5, Chambreau's Factory Site Addition, for \$13,500, which is a fair and reasonable price.
