

RESOLUTION No. 233

Resolution denying the application of Michael E. O'Keefe for service connected disability benefits.

WHEREAS, Michael E. O'Keefe, a member of the Bureau of Fire, sustained a fractured right leg on December 23, 1983 which incapacitated him for a short time, and

WHEREAS, Michael E. O'Keefe has applied for service connected disability benefits pursuant to Section 5-115 of the Charter of the City of Portland, Oregon, and

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees of the Fire and Police Disability and Retirement Fund has reviewed the application of Michael E. O'Keefe and has determined that he is ineligible for the benefits requested, and

WHEREAS, appropriate findings and an order denying the aforesaid application are attached hereto as Exhibit "A" and by this reference made a part hereof, now, therefore

BE IT RESOLVED that the findings of fact, conclusions of law, opinion and order appearing in Exhibit "A" be adopted as the determination of the Board of Trustees with respect to the application of Michael E. O'Keefe for service connected disability benefits.
