Comments by International Container Terminal Services, Inc. ("ICTSI") Oregon (Submitted via email and U.S. Mail)

Dear Commissioners:

ICTSI operates a container shipping facility at Terminal 6 ("T6") at the Port of Portland. As a company involved in national and international transport and trade to and from the Port of Portland (and other ports), ICTSI supports strong, economically viable communities and partnering with local, state and federal representatives and agencies to further projects that enhance economic growth.

We write to comment on the proposed siting of the Pembina Propane Export Terminal at the Port of Portland. Based on the publicly available information regarding the siting of the proposed Pembina terminal, ICTSI's operations at T6 would very likely be impacted when an LPG vessel is at berth at the proposed Pembina Terminal, in transit at the Columbia River Bar and/or Columbia River, or in transit past our container terminal at T6.

To date, ICTSI has not been provided assurances that these concerns are unfounded, or that the proposed Pembina Terminal would not interfere with either the land or vessel operations of ICTSI at T6. Therefore, we are unable to support this project until the above assurances are made clear to us.

We respectfully request that the Commissioners obtain a full and complete understanding of the impacts of the proposed Pembina Terminal on the existing operations of ICTSI (and others at the Port of Portland) as part of your deliberations on approving the T6 Environmental Overlay Zone Boundary and Code Amendment.
