Purpose of proposed legislation and background information:

The purpose of this legislation is to authorize a grant application to Oregon Office of State Fire Marshal (OSFM) for a grant to pay for two separate advanced training programs for the PF&R HazMat Team and Station 24 specialty-trained land-based marine and flammable liquid program personnel.

- If PF&R receives this grant it will provide much needed advanced training for the PF&R specialty teams primarily responsible for handling hazardous materials transportation accidents and incidents.
- This training supports the City's Emergency Preparedness policies.
