I am Susan West, Chair of RP Condo Security Committee. I am turning in 154 signatures collected this week. You have also received many emails.

We want you to know that the RiverPlace docks, parks and waterfront are loved and used by thousands of Portlanders, as well as hundreds of us that are residents.

In the last 5 years, things have gone downhill. The waterfront has gone from being a jewel to an armpit. IT's an embarrassment to our city, a danger to our citizens. Citizens are in an uproar down there.

My 90 year old mom, visiting teenagers, paddlers and tourists cannot safely walk alone in our River Place neighborhood on some days and most nights! My family and friends are offered narcotics on the Esplanade! There is human excrement floating near our docks! I pick up drug needles and see excrement all over our neighborhood! Our cars are prowled and residents intimidated.

Bikers with kids going to OHSU day care or International School, PSU Students & commuters peddle on dangerous streets and sidewalks to avoid the vagrant population that have taken over the wonderful and expensive new bike path under the Harrison MAX overpass!

Enough! Volunteers have been cleaning these areas weekly but we want the city to pass a budget sufficient to consistently clean up and care for what we have in high use areas like RP.

Our parks need enforcement which calls for an adequate budget! Our citizens need protection. Galina Burley, Parks Security, has been very responsive to our efforts to improve things. The contract between parks and Sheriff's River patrol, putting Deputy Shanks and crew on our docks 10-20 hours a week has been a HUGE improvement! Down from 25 boats on dock to 7 on dock, 8 anchored by dock or 15 unlawful boats and 8 dinghies. **PLEASE RENEW THAT CONTRACT AND MAKE IT PERMANENT.**

Please put money in the budget to clean up our Park and City Public places. A very few people are holding hundreds of us hostage, as they use our public spaces as their living rooms, criminal stashes and drug dens.

We are doing our share to support this effort. We have started a RiverPlace walking patrol under ONI's Jacob Brostoff and Mark Wells, a SOLVE partnership and a Spring Cleanup with your wonderful Parks Dept. We will do our volunteer part **but we want you to do your job to budget what your city and parks staff needs to do their job in the RP area.**

We are in 100% support of PDX Parks Security, Galina Burley. She's great! Give her a bigger budget. & renew River Patrol Contract.

Dear Mayor and Government officials,

We have been homeowners at Riverplace Condominiums since 2003. We bought in this area while our daughter was attending PSU. At the time we felt it was one of the safest places for her to live. She worked for a brief time at Newport Bay on the water and she felt safe walking to work in the dark. I would not feel the same now. I have seen a decline in the infrastructure on that particular dock and the surrounding water area. We have now been residents of Riverplace since 2012 and we have seen an increasing problem of trash, unsightly boats, drug deals on the docks, dogs running loose and the general feeling of uneasiness when approaching the docks and river area. We are proud to see how the community has come together for this issue and we hope that you will continue to have the enforcement in place for our safety and the well-being for all. We recently attended a meeting at city hall and we were encouraged with the efforts and concern by the city regarding this matter. It can't stop now as the momentum is moving forward for all of us. Portland has been a city of openness and inclusiveness. We are happy to be a part of that community but not at the price of our safety and those around us. This will not only hurt our property values but also the future of Portland in the decline of tourists to our city.
