I urge you to reject the proposed Pembina terminal because Portland should not actively participate any further in the fossil fuel export industry. Doing so would be inconsistent with our city's Climate Change Action Plan. Such a terminal would create a large hazardous zone, threatening the health and safety of Portland residents. Moreover, Pembina's application fails to address the hazards posed by huge quantities of explosive propane moving through our communities by rail and ship. The Planning and Sustainability Commission should say "no" to Pembina because some of the biggest threats to our communities go unaddressed in the application.
