

ORDINANCE No. 187121

- * Accept a grant in the amount of \$342,437 from the Federal Emergency Management Agency for Assistance to Firefighter Grant FY 2014 to fund firefighter bailout systems (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds

1. Portland Fire & Rescue applied to Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) for a grant in the amount of \$342,437 for Assistance to Firefighter Grant (AFG) FY 2014 on November 27, 2014; and
2. FEMA has notified the City of Portland that it will award a grant for the AFG FY 2014 to Portland Fire & Rescue in the amount of \$342,437.

NOW THEREFORE, The Council directs:


- a. The Mayor is hereby authorized to accept on behalf of the City of Portland a grant from FEMA for the AFG FY 2014 in the amount of \$342,437.
- b. Appropriations will be made during the FY 2015-16 Fall BMP.
- c. The Office of Management & Finance Grants Management Division is authorized to perform all administrative matters in relation to the grant application, grant agreement or amendments, requests for reimbursement from the grantor, and to submit required online grant documents on the Mayor's behalf.
- d. The Fire Chief of Portland Fire & Rescue of the City of Portland is authorized to accept on behalf of the City of Portland any subsequent modifications by FEMA for the AFG FY 2014, award number EMW-2014-FO-00712, provided such modifications do not increase the City of Portland's financial obligation or risk. Any modifications that increase the City of Portland's financial obligation or risk must be authorized by the Portland City Council.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because a delay would unnecessarily delay the City's ability to perform the activities authorized by the grant. Therefore this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
