Purpose of proposed legislation and background information:

The Office for Community Technology recommends that Council extend the term of the rightof-way use agreement with Sprint Spectrum, LP through June 30, 2017. The extension would preserve the existing relationship between the carrier and the City while providing time for the two parties to negotiate new terms and conditions. This would be the first extension of the rightof-way use agreement granted to Sprint Spectrum, LP in 2012.

It is also necessary to amend the Ordinance to provide certainty to the parties on the remittance annual inflation for the proper and effective administration of Sprint Spectrum, LP's annual payments.

Financial and budgetary impacts:

The City will continue to receive franchise fees from this wireless carrier's use of the right-ofway. This revenue is intended for the general fund and is not new revenue. This ordinance extension would not affect staffing levels now or in future years.

Community impacts and community involvement:

No future public involvement is anticipated or necessary as this Ordinance extends the term of an existing right-of-way use agreement.
