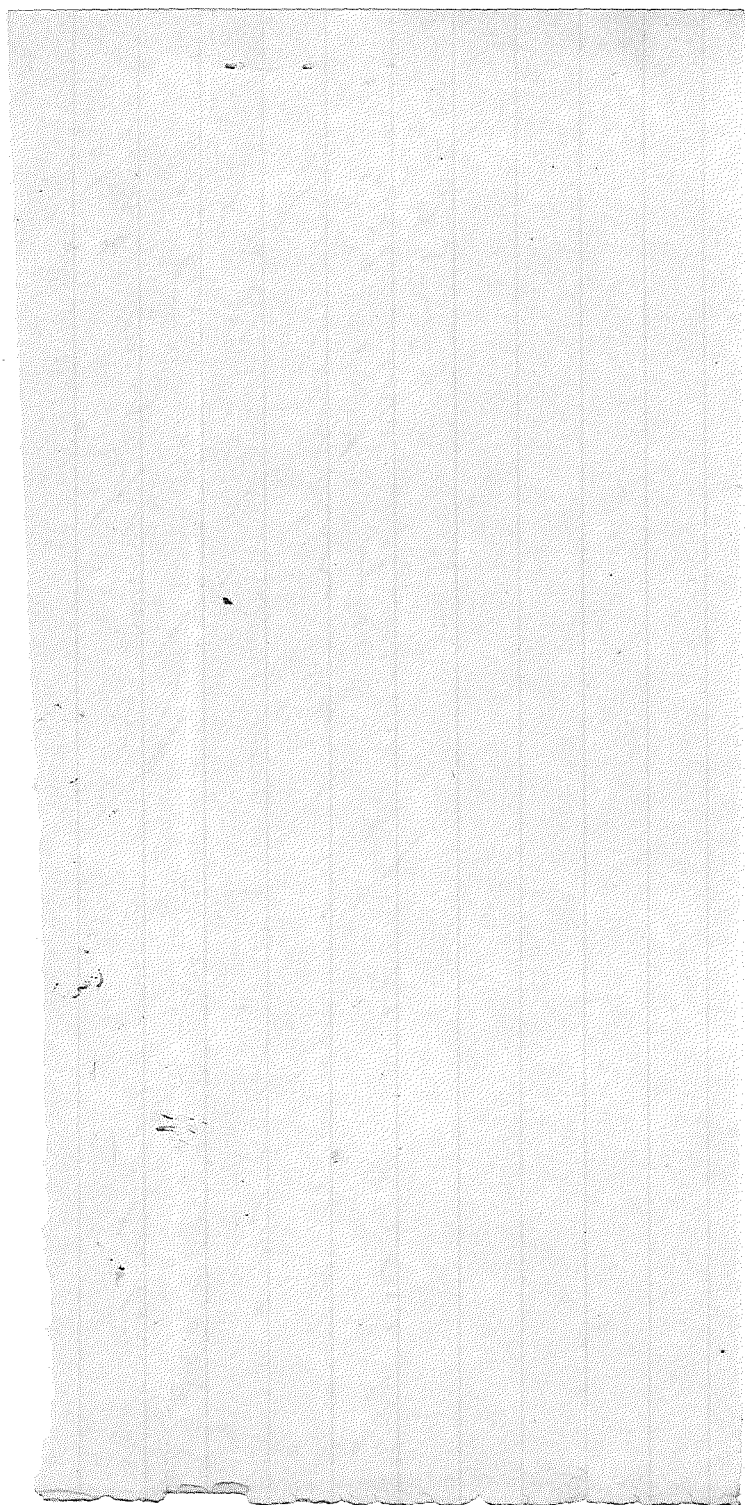


Section 3rd

That any person or persons violating
section one of this ordinance
shall upon conviction before
the recorder be fined in a sum
not less than \$5 nor more than
\$25.



An ordinance to prevent and remove
obstructions from the streets and sidewalks
of the city of Portland.

The people of the city of Portland
do ordain as follows,

Sec 1st That no person or persons shall obstruct
any street or side walk within the limits of this
city, by leaving to remain longer than two
hours, any merchandise, boxes, building ma-
terials, or any other article which may prevent
a free passage over any part of such street
or side walk. provided that nothing in this
section shall be so construed as to preclude
the right of builders to make use of so much
of said street or walk, not to exceed one half the
width, as may be necessary
for use in the construction of any building
(then) in process of erection on said street

Sec 2^d

That the Street Commissioner is hereby authorized
and required to notify all persons (obstructing
or having obstructed any street or sidewalk in
violation of section 1st of this ordinance) to remove
the same forthwith, and if any person or per-
sons neglect (for a period of six hours,
to remove such obstruction; ^{after} he or they have
received said notice, said obstruction shall be
removed under the direction of said Street
Commissioner and at the expense of the offender
or offenders; which expense, if not paid forthwith
by the offender or offenders, shall be recovered against
him or them in an action brought in the name
of the city of Portland, before the Recorder, together
with the costs of such action)

An Ordinance to prevent and remove obstructions from the streets and side-walks of the City of Portland,

The people of the City of Portland do ordain as follows,

Sect 1st That no person or persons shall obstruct any street or side-walk within the limits of this City, by leaving to remain longer than two hours, any merchandise, boxes, building materials or any other article which may prevent a free passage over any part of such street or side-walk: Provided, that nothing in this section shall be so construed as to preclude the right of builders to make use of so much of said street or walk, not to exceed one half the width, as may be necessary for use, in the construction of any building (then) in process of erection on said street.

Sect 2nd, That the Street Commissioner is hereby authorized and required to notify all persons (obstructing or having obstructed any street or side-walk in violation of section first of this ordinance) to remove the same forthwith, and if any person or persons neglect (for a period of six hours, to remove such obstruction after he or they have received said notice, said obstruction shall be removed under the direction of said Street Commissioner, and at the expense of the offender or offenders, which expense if not paid forthwith, by the offender or offenders, shall be recovered against him or them.

in an action brought in the name of the City of Portland, before the Recorder together with the Costs of such action.)

Sect 3rd; That any person or persons violating section one of this Ordinance shall upon Conviction before the recorder be fined in a sum not less than five dollars, nor more than twenty five dollars.

Sect 4th This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its approval by the Mayor.
