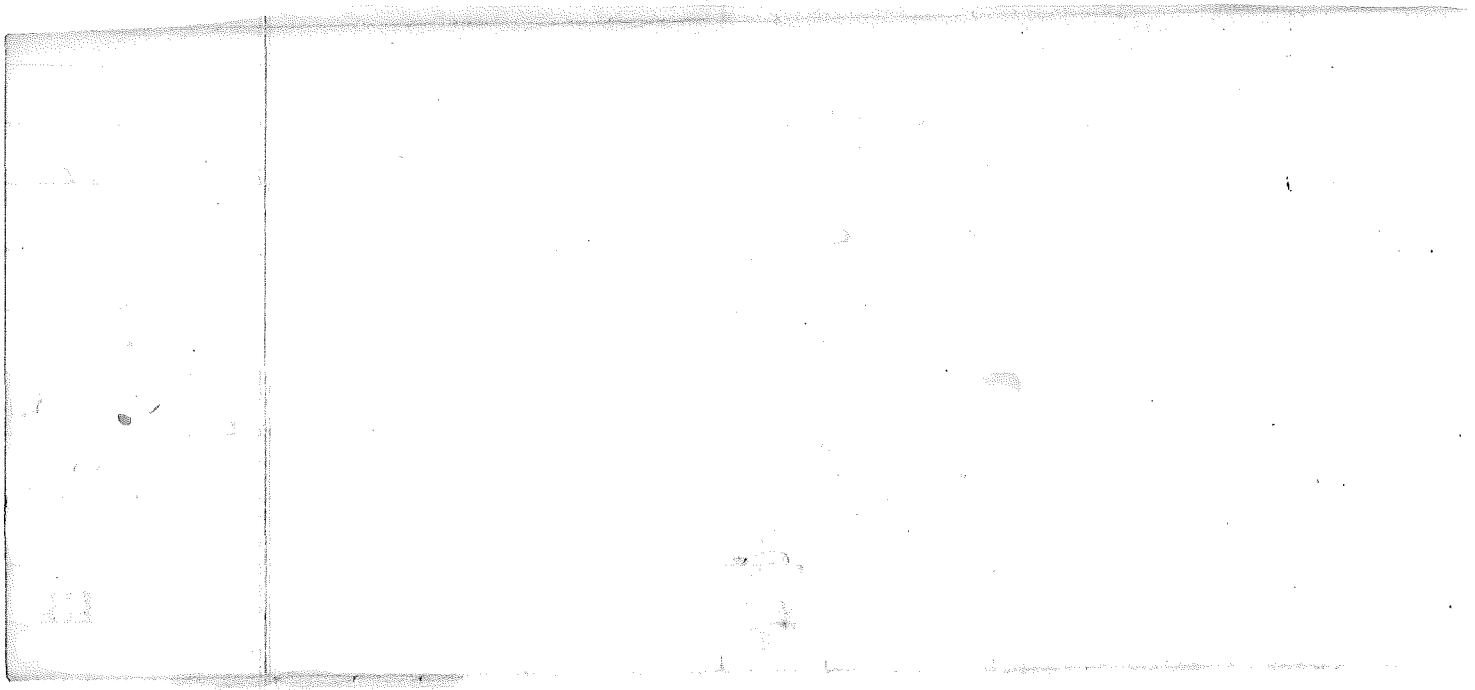

An Ordinance authorizing the Street Commissioner to grade and lay side walks on a portion of first Street.

Section 1st

~~The people~~

The people of the City of Portland do ordain as follows: That the Street Commissioner be, and is hereby ~~authorized~~ and required to grade and lay side walks, on so much of first Street as the owners of the property adjacent or abutting on both sides thereof. Shall neglect or refuse to grade and lay side walks, as provided by the City ordinances.

Section 2nd That the expense of grading and laying side walks, as provided in Section one of this ordinance, shall be paid by the property owners adjacent or abutting on both sides of said Street, in proportion to the amount so expended by said Street Commissioner, and provided the owner or owners of any property so ordered to be graded and the side walks to be laid shall refuse or neglect to pay for the same the Street Commissioner is hereby authorized to collect the same by law.

Section 3rd That the laying of all the side walks and grading, provided for by Section one of this ordinance shall be done under the direction of the Street Commissioner, and in accordance with the Plans and Specifications for grading and laying side walks on first Street.

Section 4th This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after it is approved by the Mayor.
