an ordinance to authorize and require
the ^{grading and} laying of Side Walks on a part of the
Cross Streets, from front to front street.

Section 1st The people of the City of Portland do ordain
as follows: That the owners of all lots in
the City of Portland, Situated on the following
named Streets, To wit, Pine Street, Oak Street,
"Stark Street," "Washington Street," "Alder Street,"
"Morrison Street," "Gumhill Street," Taylor Street,
and Salmon, according to the plot of said
City, are required at their own expense, on
or before the first Day February 1836,
to grade and lay a side walk nine feet
in width, on both sides of the above named
Streets from front to front street.

Section 2^d That all the plank used in ^{grading} ~~the~~ ^{grading or excavating} the said side walks, shall ~~be two inch plank~~
and shall have square edges and be of good sound
Lumber, and shall not exceed nine inches
in width, provided that nothing in the two
first Sections of this ordinance shall be so
constructed as to prevent any lot holder
laying a good and substantial brick or
stone side ~~side~~ walk in front of his property.

Section 3^d That all of said work shall be done
in accordance with the established ^{grade} of said Streets,
and under the Direction & Supervision of the Street
Commissioners of the City of Portland.

Turn over.

Section 4 and the said Side Walks mentioned
in Section one & two in this ordinance, shall
be constructed according to the plan, adapted
by the City Council, for the construction of side
walks on First Street in this City.

Section 5th of this ordinance shall take effect
from and after its approval by the Mayor
