

Ordinance No 47

An Ordinance to provide for a Water Cistern Fund
The people of the City of Portland do
ordain as follows

- Sect 1 That there be and is hereby appropriated
from the General funds of the City to a Special
Fund the sum of One Thousand and Two
Hundred (\$1200.) Dollars for the purpose of
defraying the expenses of constructing Water
Cisterns for the use of the Fire Department.
- 2^d That said fund shall be designated as The
Water Cistern Fund
- 3^d That the City Treasurer be and is hereby directed
to set apart said amount of such monies, and
report the state of the fund in like manner to that
of other funds appropriated for special purposes.
That all and each order upon this fund shall
be drawn as presented by the City Charter
- 4 That this ordinance shall be in force
and effect from and after its approval
by the Mayor
