

Finance Ch 46

An Ordinance to authorize and require the grading and laying of sidewalks on Second Street between Ash & Jefferson Streets and also on all Croft Streets from First to Second Street between Ash and Jefferson Streets inclusive

Sec 1st The People of Portland do Ordain as follows That the Owners of all lots between Ash and Jefferson Streets and of all lots on Croft Streets between First and Second Streets from Ash to Jefferson Streets inclusive — be and are hereby required at their own expense on or before the first day of October next ensuing to grade and lay sidewalks opposite their respective lots on said Second & Croft Streets nine feet wide

Sec 2nd That all plank or timber used in planking said sidewalks shall equal or exceed two inches in thickness and the edges of the same shall be square, and of good sound lumber. Provided that nothing in this Ordinance shall be so construed as to prevent the Owners of any lots from laying a good substantial brick sidewalk opposite their respective property

Sec 3rd That all of this work provided for in this Ordinance shall be done under the

direction and supervision of the Street
Commissioner of the City of Portland
dec 4th That the said Street Commissioner
with the aid of the City Surveyor is
empowered and required to prepare
a plan for the laying of said sidewalks
and to present the same to the City
Council and if approved by them, the
Street Commissioner shall direct and
superintend the execution of the same
in accordance therewith.

Sec 5th This Ordinance shall take effect
and be in force from and after its
Approval by the Mayor
