Section 2 That the ditches for laying pipes
shall be sunk two feet and that the pipes
conducting ^{the water} shall be under the surface or
level of the established grade of the streets &
And that no pipes shall be laid ^{from six to ten inches} so as to interfere
with the erecting of sewers. Provided that nothing
in this ordinance shall be so construed
as to grant any exclusive right or privilege
of conducting water into the city

An Ordinance entitled an Ordinance

Sec 1. The People of the city of Portland
do ordain as follows. That Stephen
Coffin, Finley Cornushes & Jacob Blinn
or their assigns be and are hereby
granted the priviledge of laying pipes
through the streets of the city of
Portland for the purpose of conducting
water ^{through} ~~to~~ the city

Sec 3 - his ordinance shall
be in force and take effect
from and after its approval
by the Mayor,
