This is essentially the same definition from Webster's Unabridged Dictionary Noun. Ecol. A system formed by the interaction of a community of organisms with their environment.

Personally, I'd favor Webster's in that it uses the term organisms which implies the inclusion of bacteria and other organisms one does not normally associated with animals or plants but are essential to healthy soils and environment. I do, however, like the addition of the word, dynamic in the USFWS.

Therefore, I'd suggest the following definition for Escosystem, which it seems to be should defined, since Ecosystem Services is in the glossary.
