An Ordinance authorizing the committee on Streets of the Common Council of the city of Portland to lease lot no.25 and the south eleven and one-half feet of lot 26 in block 318, Couch's Addition to the city of Portland for a slip and approach for the Albina Ferry.

The city of Portland does ordain as follows:

Section 1. The committee on Streets of the common council of the city of Portland are hereby authorized to lease from the owners thereof, lot no.25 and the south eleven and a half feet of lot no.26 in block 318, couch's Addition to the city of Portland for the use of the public and for a west approach and slip of the Albina Ferry, upon such terms and for such length of time, not exceeding two years as may be agreed upon between the said Committee on Streets and the owner of said property and enter into a written lease therefor on behalf of the city of Portland, upon such terms and conditions as may be agreed upon between the owners of said property and the said Committee on Streets, provided, that the price to be paid for the lease of the above mentioned property shall not exceed fifty dollars (\$50.00) per month.

The said Committee on Streets are hereby further authorized to enter into a contract with Multnomah County for the payment of the rental of said lots and parts of lots hereinbefore described and to do all other acts and things necessary to secure a roadway, ferryslips, approaches and rights necessary or convenient to carry the provisions of this ordinance.
