

Ordinance No. 760

(IMPROVEMENT)

An Ordinance declaring the cost of improving as a district improvement

portions of East 39th Street, East Fortieth Street, East Forty-first Street and East Forty-second Street

and assessing the property benefited thereby, declaring such assessment and directing the entry of the same in the Docket of City Liens.

The City of Portland does ordain as follows:

SECTION 1. That the Council has considered the proposed assessment for improving EAST THIRTY-NINTH STREET from the north line of Halsey Street to the southerly line of Sandy Boulevard, EAST FORTIETH STREET from the north line of Halsey Street to the southerly line of Sandy Boulevard, EAST FORTY-FIRST STREET from the north line of Halsey Street to the southerly line of Sandy Boulevard, EAST FORTY-SECOND STREET from the north line of Halsey Street to the southerly line of Broadway, extended westerly.

and all objections made thereto, and hereby ascertains, determines and declares the whole cost of said improvement in the manner provided by Ordinance No. 26923 to be the sum of

\$ 9686.59

and that the special and peculiar benefits accruing to each lot, or part thereof or

parcel of land within the assessment district, by reason of said improvement and in just proportion to such benefits, are in the respective amounts set opposite the number or description of each lot or part thereof or parcel of land in the annexed assessment roll, and said assessment roll, which is numbered 2598

is hereby adopted and approved as the assessment for said improvement, and the Auditor of the City of Portland is directed to enter a statement of the assessment hereby made in the Docket of City Liens, and cause notice thereof to be published as provided by Charter.
