

Ordinance No. 28186.

An Ordinance vacating the unnamed alley separating blocks 2 and 3, the unnamed alley separating blocks 4 and 5, and the unnamed alley separating blocks 6 and 7, all in Industrial Center, an addition to the City of Portland, in Multnomah County, State of Oregon, according to the duly recorded map and plat thereof.

WHEREAS, due notice was given by advertisement for four consecutive weeks in the Portland Daily Abstract, the City Official Newspaper of the said City of Portland (the first publication of said notice being in the issue of October 7, 1913, of said newspaper, and the last publication of said notice being in the issue of November 4, 1913, of said newspaper) that at a regular meeting of the Council of the said City of Portland to be held on Wednesday, the 12th day of November, 1913, a petition would be presented to said Council by Lewis Wiley Hydraulic Company, a corporation, Ada Pearl Cottle Cooke, Blanche Cottle McMurray and Frederick H. Strong, praying for the vacation of the unnamed alley separating blocks 2 and 3, the unnamed alley separating blocks 4 and 5, and the unnamed alley separating blocks 6 and 7, all in Industrial Center, an addition to the City of Portland, in Multnomah County, State of Oregon, according to the duly recorded map and plat thereof, and as the said several alleys extend from St. Helens County Road on the south, northerly to Industrial avenue, which notice, with due proof of its publication subscribed and sworn to by W. T. Phillips, foreman of the printer of the said Portland Daily Abstract, is filed with the Auditor

of said City; and,

WHEREAS, said petition was duly advertised and presented to said Council on the date named in said notice, and within named, which petition duly set forth the particular description of the said alleys proposed in said petition to be vacated, and the reason for such vacation, to which there was appended as a part thereof and as a basis for said vacation and for the granting of the prayer of said petition, the written consent, duly acknowledged before a Notary Public in and for the State of Oregon, of all of the owners in fee simple of all of the real estate fronting on both sides of the said alleys proposed in said petition to be vacated, and for the entire length thereof (neither of said alleys being continuous in either direction, and the whole of each of said alleys being proposed in said petition to be vacated); and the written consent, duly acknowledged before a Notary Public in and for the State of Oregon, of all the owners of all the real estate in the said plat of Industrial Center, and all being done as required by and in accordance with the Charter and ordinances of the said City of Portland, Oregon; and,

WHEREAS, the said Council, upon the representation of the said petition and the filing of proof of said notice, did fix a meeting of said Council on Wednesday, the 19th day of November, 1913, as the regular time and place of hearing said petition and objections thereto, if any be filed; and,

WHEREAS, said petition was duly called on the 19th day of November, 1913, and no objections to said petition or the granting thereof, or to the vacation of the said alleys proposed therein to be vacated have been filed; and,

WHEREAS, said Council has ascertained and determined and does hereby cause, it to be made a matter of record that the written consent, duly acknowledged before a Notary Public in and for the State of Oregon, of all the owners in fee simple of all of the real estate fronting on both sides of the said alleys proposed in said petition to be vacated, and for the entire length thereof (neither of said alleys being continuous in either direction, and the whole of each of said alleys being proposed in said petition to be vacated); and the written consent, duly acknowledged before a Notary Public in and for the State of Oregon, of all the owners of all the real estate in the said plat of Industrial Center, has been duly obtained, and that the public interest will not be prejudiced by the said vacation prayed for, and the Council so finding; now, therefore,

The City of Portland does ordain as follows:

Section 1. That the unnamed alley separating blocks 2 and 3, the unnamed alley separating blocks 4 and 5, and the unnamed alley separating blocks 6 and 7, all in Industrial Center, an addition to the City of Portland, Multnomah County, State of Oregon, according to the duly recorded map and plat thereof, and as the said several alleys extend from St. Helens County Road on the south, northerly to Industrial avenue, be and the same are hereby vacated.
