

An Ordinance granting a revocable permit to Spokane, Portland and Seattle Railroad Company and to the Oregon-Washington Railroad and Navigation Company to construct and maintain a spur track in East Second street, and declaring an emergency.

The City of Portland does ordain as follows:

Section 1. That there be and is hereby granted to Spokane, Portland and Seattle Railroad Company and the Oregon-Washington Railroad and Navigation Company the right and privilege of constructing and maintaining a single standard gauge spur track on the east fifteen feet of East Second street from the north line of East Ankeny street to a point 120 feet north thereof.

Section 2. This permit is conditioned that it may at any time be revoked by the Council of the City of Portland, and no expenditure of money, lapse of time, or tacit consent on the part of the City of Portland shall give the grantees herein any vested right to maintain said track. This permit is further conditioned that said grantees will at their own cost and expense, during the exercise of the privilege hereby granted, pave, repave, repair or otherwise improve and maintain in good condition that portion of the street occupied by the track to be constructed under authority of this ordinance, and is further conditioned that said grantees will, when so ordered by the City of Portland, remove said track and restore that portion of the street, pave-

ment or sidewalk disturbed or torn up by such removal  
and place the same in as good condition as the remain-  
ing portion of said street.

Section 3. Said grantees shall execute a bond to  
the City of Portland in the penal sum of \$1,000, condi-  
tioned that the provisions of this ordinance shall be  
complied with, and that said track will be removed when  
ordered by the City, and the street and sidewalk re-  
stored.

Section 4. An emergency is hereby declared to ex-  
ist in this: The street on which this spur track is to  
be constructed is in need of immediate improvement,  
and it is necessary that said spur track be constructed  
immediately in order that the improvement of said street  
may not be delayed unnecessarily; therefore this ordi-  
nance shall be in force and effect from and after its  
passage by the Council.
