

ORDINANCE No. 187257

*Amend Intergovernmental Agreement with Oregon Department of Transportation for design and construction of the SE Holgate & SE Ramona: 122nd to 136th Ave Sidewalks project. (Ordinance; amend Contract No. 30002698)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. The Portland Bureau of Transportation applied for a Transportation Enhancement (TE) Grant in the amount of \$1,487,000 on September of 2010 for the SE Holgate & SE Ramona: 122nd to 136th Avenue Sidewalks project.
2. The City Council passed Ordinance No. 185317, dated May 16, 2012, approving the Intergovernmental Agreement (IGA) to receive the grant from Oregon Department of Transportation.
3. The City Council approved Amendment #1 on December 11, 2013. This Amendment extended the schedule.
4. Amendment #2 will also extend the milestones and reallocate funds from construction to design and ROW. The total funds will not change but will just be reallocated within phases.
5. The Bureau's level of confidence in the cost estimates for this project is moderate. The project is designed and ready to bid.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Commissioner-in-Charge is hereby authorized to execute an amendment, approved as to form by the City Attorney, with the Oregon Department of Transportation for the design of the SE Holgate & SE Ramona: 122nd to 136th Avenue Sidewalks project, in a form similar to the contract attached as Exhibit A.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because a delay would unnecessarily delay the City's ability to perform the activities authorized by the grant; therefore this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.


