

Ordinance No. 50059

Dist. 30 C-2871

An Ordinance adopting the City Engineer's report made pursuant to Resolution No. 16397 for the proposed widening and extension of Powell Street and Powell Valley Road, from Milwaukie Street to 50th Street Southeast; the widening and extension of Brooklyn Street, from East 7th Street to Milwaukie Street; the widening of Milwaukie Street, from Pershing Street to Gideon Street; the widening of Woodward Avenue, between East 10th Street and Milwaukie Street; and the extension of East 17th Street, from Pershing Street to Powell Street, in the City of Portland, Multnomah County, State of Oregon, and declaring an emergency.

The City of Portland, does ordain as follows:

Section 1. The City Engineer's report filed with the City Auditor June 7th, 1926, pursuant to Resolution No. 16397 for the proposed widening and extension of Powell Street and Powell Valley Road, from Milwaukie Street to 50th Street Southeast; the widening and extension of Brooklyn Street, from East 7th Street to Milwaukie Street; the widening of Milwaukie Street, from Pershing Street to Gideon Street; the widening of Woodward Avenue between East 10th Street and Milwaukie Street; and the extension of East 17th Street, from Pershing Street to Powell Street, in the City of Portland, Multnomah County, State of Oregon, is hereby adopted, approved and confirmed, which report is in words and figures as follows:

Section 2 Inasmuch as this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the City of Portland in this; that the earliest practicable completion of the proceedings herein is necessary to the end that the street may be improved and made ready for public use upon the completion of the Ross Island Bridge, therefore an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
