

ORDINANCE NO. 50169

An Ordinance authorizing the employment of one (1) superintendent of construction, two (2) draftsmen, and one (1) stenographer, making an appropriation out of the Water Fund to provide for the payment of such services, and declaring an emergency.

The City of Portland Does Ordain as Follows:

Section 1. That the Commissioner of Public Utilities be and he is hereby authorized to employ one (1) superintendent of construction at a salary not to exceed five hundred dollars (\$500.00) per month, one (1) draftsman at a salary not to exceed two hundred twenty-five dollars (\$225.00) per month, one (1) draftsman at a salary not to exceed one hundred seventy five dollars (\$175.00) per month, and one (1) stenographer at a salary not to exceed one hundred twenty-five dollars (\$125.00) per month, in the Engineering Department of the Bureau of Water Works, all to be employed for a period of approximately three and one-half months' time during the season of 1926 for the purpose of performing the required services in connection with the construction of the proposed Bear Creek Storage Dam on the Bull Run River for the development of the water supply of the City of Portland.

Section 2. That the sum of Four Thousand Dollars (\$4,000.00) be and is hereby appropriated out of the Water Fund to provide for the payment of the services and expenses authorized under the provisions of Section 1 of this Ordinance.

Section 3. Inasmuch as this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, peace and safety of the City of Portland, in this: In order that the Bear Creek Storage Dam may be completed without delay, it is necessary that the services above mentioned be engaged immediately; therefore an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
