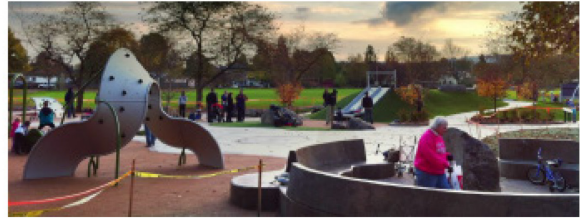
# Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA)

- Title I: Employment
- Title II: State and Local Government Activities
- Title III: Public Accommodations

- 260 publically-accessible sites surveyed
- 20,355 barriers identified
- 17,008 barriers scheduled

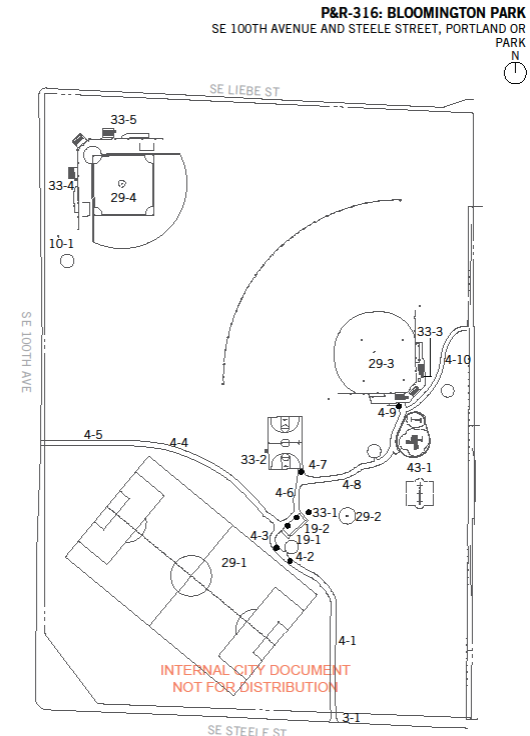

Notes: Slope of the curb ramp is 10%

<b>Regrade surface</b>	
Notes: Cross slope of asphalt path is 10%

Notes: Surface level change is 1" due to broken asphalt (1/4" max, up to 1/2" with a bevel).

<b>4 - 4</b>	<b>Walk</b> <span style="float: right;">Category: 2</span>
<b>Provide a firm, stable and slip resistant surface</b> <span style="float: right;">\$53</span>	
Notes: Surface of asphalt path is not firm, stable and slip-resistant due to plants growing in path for 3-1/2 linear feet.

<b>4 - 5</b>	<b>Walk</b> <span style="float: right;">Category: 2</span>
<b>Regrade surface</b> <span style="float: right;">\$330</span>	
Notes: Cross slope of asphalt path is 2.4% to 2.9% for 22 linear feet (2.0% max).
