

Ordinance No. 500

An ordinance accepting certain property for the widening of Alberta Street, and declaring an emergency.

The City of Portland does ordain as follows:

Section 1. That the following described property be and is hereby accepted by the City of Portland for street purposes:

Beginning at the southwest corner of lot 9, block "A", Walnut Park, an addition within the corporate limits of the City of Portland; thence southwesterly to the intersection of the north line of Alberta Street with the east line of Block "O" M. Patton Tracts, said course being the south line of that portion of Congress Street vacated by Ordinance No. 55221 passed by the Council of the City of Portland September 5th, 1928; thence west along the north line of Alberta Street 50 feet to a point; thence northeasterly in a straight line to a point on the east line of said block "O" M. Patton Tract 10.50 feet north of the north line of Alberta Street; thence northeasterly in a straight line to the place of beginning. (Deeded by School District No. 1)

Section 2. That the City Engineer be and he is hereby directed to have the deed to the property described in Section 1 of this ordinance placed on record.

Section 3. Inasmuch as this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, peace and safety of the City of Portland in this: It is necessary that this property be immediately opened to the public for the widening of Alberta Street; therefore an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
