ORDINANCE No. 187402

* Accept and appropriate a grant from the Oregon Office of Emergency Management in the amount of \$14,055 for the Portland Region Community Emergency Response Team /Neighborhood Emergency Team Training and Equipment Program (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. The Oregon Office of Emergency Management (OEM) administers the State Homeland Security Program (SHSP) grant, which will support disaster preparedness in the Portland Region.
- 2. The grant will provide funding to better equip and train Neighborhood Emergency Teams (NETs) located in and around Portland, to better assist residents and communities after a disaster occurs.

NOW THEREFORE, The Council directs:

- a. The Mayor is hereby authorized to accept on behalf of the City of Portland, State Homeland Security Program (SHSP) grant funds in the amount of \$14,055 and to execute the award.
- b. The FY 2015/2016 budget is hereby amended as follows GRANT FUNDS

Fund - 217

Business Area – EM

Bureau Program Expenses - \$14,055

- c. The Office of Management & Finance Grants Office is authorized to perform all administrative matters in relation to the grant application, grant agreement or amendments, requests for reimbursement from the grantor, and to submit required online grant documents on the Mayor's behalf.
- d. The Director of the Portland Bureau of Emergency Management of the City of Portland is authorized to accept on behalf of the City of Portland any subsequent modifications by the Oregon Office of Emergency Management for the State Homeland Security Program (SHSP), grant number 15-249, provided such modifications do not increase the City of Portland's financial obligation or risk. Any modifications that increase the City of Portland's financial obligation or risk must be authorized by the Portland City Council.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because a delay is likely to impair the City's ability to perform the activities authorized by the grant. Therefore this ordinance shall be in full force and effective from and after its passage by Council.
