Purpose of proposed legislation and background information:

In October 1995, the City Council passed an ordinance supporting the Columbia Boulevard Wastewater Treatment Plant (CBWTP) Citizen Advisory Committee's (CAC) previous and ongoing efforts. The CAC represents a wide range of public interests including neighborhood, business and industry, environmental, recreational, and educational. The CAC works with the Wastewater Group to ensure that Environmental Services implements treatment plant and other north Portland projects in a way that serves the surrounding community and addresses their needs and concerns.

Environmental Services will be honoring the 20 Years of Service that the CAC has provided.
