# CenturyLink Prism TV

- Press menu on the remote
- Select Settings to the right
- Select Television, click OK on the remote
- Scroll down to Closed Captioning
- Set Closed Captions On, Digital Closed Captioning is set to Automatic, and Standard Closed Captioning is set to Closed Caption 1

- Then click on Closed Captions.
- Select "On."
- There is an Option area where the viewer can adjust the font size, color, etc.
- Press Save and you're done.
