## Ordinance No. 20621

An Ordinance adopting the report of the Viewers in the matter of the proposed opening, laying out and establishing of Rural Avenue from the west line of East Fourteenth. Street, to a line that is 30 feet easterly from and parallel with a line that is midway between the tracks of the Oregon Tater Fower and Railway Company

making an assessment of the benefits and damages set forth in said report. The City of Portland does ordain as follows:

SECTION I.

WHEREAS, The Council, deeming if expedient to open, lay out and establish Lural Avenue from the west line of East Fourteenth to a line that is 30 feet easterly from and parallel with a line

that is midway between the tracks of the Oregon Water Power and Nailway Company

We then adjourned to meet on Thursday, the 5th day of August, 1909, at 4 o'clock P. M. at which time we proceeded to the proposed opening, laying out and establishing of said avenue through the whole length thereof, and the grounds and improvements on, along and adjacent to said proposed avenus, and on that and subsequent days to which we adjourned, not exceeding one week at any one time, and after taking into consideration the claim of the party hereinbefore mentioned, we determined, found and assessed the damages that will be sustained by the taking of property and the benefits that will be derived by the parties respectively by reason of the opening, laying out and establishing of said avenue as aforesaid. The proposedopening, laying out and establishing of Rural Avenue is 60 feet in width and is more particularly bounded and described as follows, to-wit: Commencing at a point in the west line of East Fourteenth Street where the same is intersector by a westerly extension of the south line of Rural Avenue as laid out in City View Park Addition to mast Portland, and running thence westerly along said

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westerly extension of the south line of Rural Avenue 186.45 feet to a point 30 feat easterly from a line midway between the tracks of the Oregon Water Fewer and Railway Company; thence northerly 30 feet easterly from and parallel with a line midway between the tracks of the Oregon Water Power and Railway Com pany, 62.34 fest to a point; thence easterly 50 fest north of and mallel with the south line of the proposed opening, laying out and establishing of Runal Avenue as above described 169,51 foot to an intersection with the west line of East Fourteenth Street; thence south along the west line of East Fourteenth Street 60 feet to the place of begins ing.

We find and determine that the persons named in the table next following, as the owners of lots or parcels of land set opposite their names respectively, no part of which will be required or taken for the opening, laying out and establishing of said proposed avenue, will sustain no damages whatever, but said persons will be specially benefited thereby, and we find and assess the value of the bënefits that will aborue to said persons as the owners of tracts of land aforesaid, to be the sums set opposite their names respectively, which sums are also the excess of benefits over damages, scorning to said persons by the opening, laying out and establishing of said avenue, as aforesaid.

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
