

Ordinance No. 72551

An Ordinance to change and re-establish the curb lines of N.E. Sandy Boulevard from the center line of N.E. 44th Avenue to the center line of N.E. 74th Avenue, and declaring an emergency.

The City of Portland does ordain as follows:

Section 1. The Council finds as to N.E. Sandy Boulevard from the center line of N.E. 44th Avenue to the center line of N.E. 74th Avenue, that in order to provide for the public convenience, wider area for vehicular traffic and vehicular parking is needed and a narrower area for pedestrian traffic is needed than heretofore provided; now, therefore, the curb lines along said portion of said boulevard are hereby changed and re-established from the locations given by Ordinances No. 46449 and No. 32924 so that the curb lines on either side of said boulevard shall be thirty (30) feet from and parallel to the center line of said boulevard.

Section 2. Inasmuch as this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, peace and safety of the City of Portland in this: In order that there be no delay in the contemplated improvement of this street; therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
