

Ordinance No. 72701

An Ordinance to name certain new streets N. W. CULEBRA AVENUE AND N. W. 61ST AVENUE, in the City of Portland.

The City of Portland does ordain as follows:

Section 1. That a new street deeded by Shell Oil Company to the public for street purposes, recorded in deed records of Multnomah County, Oregon, at page 340 of book 464, New Series, from N. W. Balboa Avenue to a line 722.72 feet northwesterly shall hereafter be designated as N. W. CULEBRA AVENUE and such new street from 722.72 feet northwesterly of N. W. Balboa Avenue to its connection with N. W. Front Avenue shall hereafter be designated as N. W. 61ST AVENUE.

Section 2. Nothing contained in this ordinance shall in any way affect the validity of any proceedings for the improvement, opening, laying-out, establishing or widening of the above-mentioned street, or for the construction of sewers or water mains, or for the establishment of grades thereon, but such proceedings shall continue and be completed as though the name of said street had not been changed or fixed.
