

An Ordinance accepting certain property for the construction of a sewer in N.E. Irving Street, and declaring an emergency.

The City of Portland does ordain as follows:

Section 1. That the following described property be and is hereby accepted by the City of Portland for sewer purposes:

Beginning at a point on the westerly extension of the center line of N.E. Irving Street, as laid out and established east of N.E. 49th Avenue, 93 feet east of the center line of N.E. 47th Avenue; thence north 45 degrees 0 minutes east, 44 feet to a point; thence north 76 degrees 0 minutes east, 189 feet; thence south 44 degrees 24 minutes east, 108 feet to a connection with the existing sewer in the westerly extension of the center line of N.E. Irving Street as laid out east of N.E. 49th Avenue. (Deeded by Sisters of Charity of Providence in Oregon)

Section 2. That the City Engineer be and he is hereby directed to have the deed to the property described in Section 1 of this ordinance placed on record.

Section 3. Inasmuch as this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, peace and safety of the City of Portland in this: It is necessary that this property be immediately opened to the public for constructing the sewer in N.E. Irving Street; therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
