### CONSENT CALENDAR

TO THE COUNCIL:

On July 29, 2015, Council approved Ordinance Number 187270 for Procurement Services to competitively solicit the SE Holgate & Ramona:  $122^{nd} - 136^{th}$  Ave SDWK (Portland) Project in accordance with PCC 5.34. The Chief Procurement Officer has advertised and received bids for Bid Number 00000111 on behalf of the Bureau of Transportation, with a project construction estimate of \$808,050.00. The Bureau of Transportation rated the level of project estimate confidence as Moderate.

Bids were opened on October 6, 2015 and ten (10) bids were received. The low bid from Brown Contracting, Inc. was deemed responsive to the solicitation requirements, thus it is recommended that Brown Contracting's bid be accepted at the estimated unit prices quoted for a total bid amount of \$723,793.50.00.

Ordinance No. 179568 authorized the Bureau of Transportation (PBOT) to participate in ODOT's Local Public Agency Certification Program for the delivery of federal-aid projects. On June 29, 2011, ODOT's Director informed the Mayor that PBOT had successfully completed the requirements to become fully certified, and City Council accepted ODOT's certification acknowledgement by Ordinance No. 184710. This is a federal-aid transportation project under the Oregon Department of Transportation (ODOT) Federal-Aid Highway Program. Under ODOT's certification, this project will be reviewed and audited by ODOT for federal-aid project compliance.

Part of the certification is that ODOT shall administer on behalf of the City, ODOT's Disadvantaged Business Enterprise (DBE), Equal Employment Opportunity, and On-The-Job Training (OJT) programs. As such, ODOT establishes the minimum DBE goals for each federal-aid project in compliance with 49 CFR 26. The criteria used in assigning project goals includes, project location, size, duration, dollar value and the availability of DBE firms that can perform identified subcontracting opportunities. This project has a 0% DBE goal. ODOT deemed Brown Contracting, Inc. to be responsive to the DBE requirement.

Brown Contracting, Inc. is located in Eugene, Oregon, and is not a State Certified M/W/ESB Contractor. They have a current City of Portland Business Tax Registration and EEO Certification, and are in Full Compliance with the Equal Benefits Program.

Funds are available for this project under Owner Cost Center T00305.
