## ordinance no. 78829

An Ordinance amending section 20-10304 (as heretofore amended) of the license and business code, by increasing the license fees on individual question and answer boards, and declaring an emergency.

The City of Portland does ordain as follows:

Section 1. Section 20-10304 of the license and business code (Ordinance No. 76398), as said section has heretofore been amended, is further amended to read as follows:

Section 20-10304. LICENSE FEES.

- Class A. An annual fee of \$100.00 and no license shall be issued for less than the full annual fee.
- Class B. An annual fee of \$25.00 and no license shall be issued for less than the full annual fee.

The following licenses shall be paid upon individual boards and shall be in addition to the license fees provided for classes A and B:

Boards having up to and including 500 holes or receptacles

25 cents each

Boards having 501 to 1000 holes or receptacles

50 cents each

Boards having 1001 to 1500 holes or receptacles

1 dollar each

Boards having more than 1500 holes or receptacles - 1 dollar each, plus 50 cents for each 500 holes or receptacles or fraction thereof in excess of 1500.

For any board having a sale price for each hole or receptable in excess of ten cents, a minimum fee of \$5.00 each shall be paid.

The fees provided for in this section shall be spolicable on and after July 1st, 1943.

Section 2. Inasmuch as this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, peace and safety of the City of Portland in this: That the license fees now imposed with respect to individual question and answer boards are found to be inadequate and the increase herein provided should become effective at the beginning of the next fiscal year; therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
